

# Mekong – ROK Cooperation Program Objectives, Outcomes and Outputs

The **Mekong - ROK Cooperation** is a strategic initiative that fosters collaboration between the Republic of Korea (ROK) and the five Mekong countries—Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand, and Viet Nam. Established as a mechanism to enhance regional integration and sustainable development, MKCF serves as an essential platform for addressing shared challenges and harnessing opportunities for economic and social progress.

Since its inception, the Mekong - ROK partnership has been guided by the principles of **mutual prosperity, inclusivity, and sustainable development**. It is rooted in the **Mekong-Han River Declaration**, which underscores the commitment of both the ROK and Mekong nations to fostering cooperation across various sectors, ensuring long-term resilience, and promoting peace and stability in the region.

## The Plan of Action (POA) 2021-2025

To operationalize the goals set forth in the Mekong-Han River Declaration, the Plan of Action (POA) 2021-2025 on Mekong – ROK Cooperation was developed as a roadmap for implementing priority programs and projects. This POA provides a structured approach to regional collaboration by focusing on seven priority sectors essential for sustainable growth and stability in the Mekong region:

- ① **Culture and Tourism** Promoting cultural exchanges, sustainable tourism development, and enhanced people-to-people connectivity.
- 2 **Human Resources Development** Strengthening education, vocational training, and capacity-building programs to develop a competitive workforce.
- 3 **Agriculture and Rural Development** Enhancing food security, sustainable farming practices, and rural economic development.
- 4 Infrastructure Improving transportation networks, digital infrastructure, and energy security to drive economic growth.
- (5) **Information and Communication Technology (ICT)** Advancing digital transformation, e-governance, and smart city initiatives.
- © Environment Addressing climate change, biodiversity conservation, and sustainable resource management.
- Non-Traditional Security Challenges Enhancing regional security through collaboration on transnational crime, public health crises, and disaster resilience. Each of these priority



areas aligns with the shared vision of fostering inclusive and sustainable development across the Mekong subregion.

# **MKCF Funding and Support for Regional Projects**

The Mekong - ROK Cooperation Fund (MKCF) translates the POA into action. The fund provides financial resources for projects that align with the seven priority sectors, ensuring tangible benefits for local communities and regional stakeholders. By supporting projects that enhance economic integration, promote knowledge-sharing, and improve institutional capacity, MKCF fosters long-term resilience and sustainable development.



#### 1. Culture and Tourism

## **Enhancing Cultural Connectivity and Sustainable Tourism in the Mekong Region**
